





### HEPATITIS C AND THE ABORIGINAL COMMUNITY



Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people are 10 times more likely to be diagnosed with hepatitis C than non indigenous population<sup>4</sup>

### HEPATITIS C AND PEOPLE WHO INJECT DRUGS

Sharing injecting equipment is the main risk factor for new cases of hepatitis C<sup>⁵</sup>

> In 2018 about 45% of people who accessed needle and syringe programs had been exposed to hepatitis C<sup>°</sup>
