- Sex without a condom when you are not vaccinated
- Needlestick injury
- Blood-to-blood
- Mother-to-baby at birth
- Toothbrushes and razors
- Needles
- Blood transfusion (donating blood or giving blood)
- Fighting
- Snorting equipment
- Tattooing
- Piercing
- Workplace exposure

There are many ways to prevent transmission:

- Safe sex (such as using condoms)
- Going to a licenced and professional tattooing and piercing salon
- Safe injecting (not reusing or sharing injecting equipment)
- Education
- Hepatitis B vaccination

- Blood-to-blood

Hepatitis C is transmitted through:

- Blood-to-blood
